2022 BUDGET INFORMATION

The cost of our proposed budget increase for a resident with a home valued at \$1,000,000 is about \$1.38/month.

The 2022 Operating Budget will provide the community with:

- Research assistance

- Programs, films, and concerts for children, teens, families, and seniors
- Downloadable books, audio-books, newspapers, films and magazines

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that a Special District Meeting vote and election of the qualified voters of the Sag Harbor Union Free School District, Sag Harbor, Suffolk County, New York, will be held at the John Jermain Memorial Library, 201 Main Street, Sag Harbor, New York on Thursday, October 7, 2021, from 10:00 a.m. to 8:00 p.m., prevailing time, for the purpose of voting upon the following items:

1. "Shall the Board of Education of the Sag Harbor Union Free School District be authorized to appropriate funds in the amount of TWO MILLION NINE HUNDRED SEVENTY-EIGHT THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED FORTY-FIVE (\$2,978,945.00) DOLLARS to be raised by a levy of a tax upon the taxable real property within the Sag Harbor Union Free School District's boundaries."

AND,

2. To elect five Trustees of the John Jermain Memorial Library as follows:

- a. To elect three trustees, to fill three (3) at-large seats each with a three-year term commencing January 1, 2022, and expiring December 31, 2024;

AND,

- b. To elect two trustees, to fill two (2) at-large seats each with a two-year term commencing January 1, 2022, and expiring December 31, 2023.
